

TOWN OF CONCORD TOWN BOARD MEETING
WORK SESSION

November 14, 2019
6:30 p.m.

The following items were discussed:

1. Supervisor Drake provided the Board with information about Stellar Dental and asked the Board to look it over and see what their thoughts are to see if this is something the Town would like to make available to employees. The only catch is that you have to go to their dentists.
2. Supervisor Drake printed out what the Erie County Legislature did regarding the AIM Funding and provided this information to the Board. The AIM funding letter authored by Supervisor Drake is on the agenda for tonight's meeting.
3. Town Clerk Schweikert received an email from the Springville Kiwanis regarding use of the Town Hall. The Kiwanis are collecting gently used books and would like to place a depository in the Town Hall and they would have a Book Sale at the Dairy Fest. The concern is that the Hulbert Library has their Book Sale at that time. Maybe this is something Councilman Drozd should take to the Library Board. The Town would not have to store the books long term; the members of Kiwanis would be emptying the depositories and storing the books elsewhere.
4. The Board reviewed the report from the Assessor's Office. This report is nothing more than a job description for the office. It does not detail what work the office is doing. The Board will ask Assessor Martin for a statistical driven report.
