

TOWN OF CONCORD TOWN BOARD MEETING  
Work Session 6:30 p.m.

September 12, 2019

The following was discussed:

1. DCO Robinson brought the Board up to date regarding a pending dog matter.
2. Supervisor Drake advised that Mortons Corners Fire Company and Legislator John Mills are hosting a Public Meeting regarding Trevett, Groth and Zoar Valley Roads. Local, State and Federal officials have been invited to discuss potential solutions. The meeting will be at the Mortons Corners Fire Company on Thursday, September 26<sup>th</sup> at 6:30 p.m.
3. Supervisor Drake discussed the Craneridge Sewer matter. An emergency declaration will need to be declared by the Board. The rock has washed away and the panic is that it could not get fixed before bad weather so if the Board declares an emergency declaration then the needed repair work can be done within 30 days. MDA Engineers has submitted a tabulation of the bids received for the project. Once the Board approves the emergency declaration, within 30 days the work will get done.
4. Councilman Drozd and Hwy Supt Dains discussed the traffic light at Waverly Street and South Cascade. There was a day when the light was not working properly and was on flash red for all directions. The Town and Village do not have the necessary equipment to fix the light. In past when this would happen, a call would be placed to New York State. Contacts were made to Erie County and also New York State to get the light fixed. Hwy Supt Dains noted that he is waiting to hear from New York State as to how this should be addressed in the future.
