Supervisor Drake opened the Special Town Board Meeting at 7:30 p.m. The purpose of this meeting is to review and approve the Kissing Bridge Special Use Permit and review the rate of pay for the Senior Center Director.

ITEM #1

Supervisor Drake started the meeting by stating that we just had the Public Hearing to review the Special Use Permit for Kissing Bridge to hold a concert on August 28<sup>th</sup>, 2021. The Planning Board has also heard the presentation from Kissing Bridge and recommends granting the Special Use Permit.

ITEM #2

Supervisor Drake stated that the second item pertains to the Senior Center Director. Eleanor is limited in the number of hours we can pay her for because of civil laws and she goes over and beyond that. She is currently paid \$15.97 per hour. She is requesting a raise to \$17.00 per hour. Supervisor Drake stated that we do have money on that line in the budget. He does recognize what Eleanor has done for us in the last five years. Councilman Drozd stated that he knows Eleanor really does go above and beyond.

Motion by Councilman Drozd, seconded by Councilman Zittel, to raise Senior Center Director, Eleanor Eschborn's, pay to \$17.00 per hour effective Tuesday, July 6<sup>th</sup>, 2021. Councilman, Krezmien, Zittel, Snyder & Drozd; Supervisor Drake, voting aye. Carried.
