Supervisor Drozd opened the hearing at 6:15 p.m. Town Clerk Schweikert had published the Notice of Public Hearing in the Springville Journal on September 21, 2023. The Public Hearing Notice was posted on the signboard at the Town Hall and on the Town's website: townofconcordny.com on September 18, 2023.

Supervisor Drozd suggested the following projects for this year: #1 project: Upgrade playground equipment to include inclusive playground equipment at Community Park; the bedding underneath the playground is not in good shape; as their #2 project: Concord Senior Center Improvements: appliances and furnishings to include tables & chairs and as their #3 project: the Rural Transit Service Van Program. Council Member Drake asked the total costs of Project #1 and Project #2 for comparison. The dollar amounts are not known at this time. The cost of tables and chairs for the Senior Center and the freezer could be more expensive than the cost to update the playground equipment. Supervisor Drozd will contact Marie Thornton, Erie County Planner, to see the if Project #1 and Project #2 could be combined.

Supervisor Drozd asked if anyone had any questions. There were no questions or comments.

The Public Hearing remained open until 6:30 p.m.
