

TOWN OF CONCORD TOWN BOARD
6:30 p.m. Work Session

December 13, 2018

The following topics were discussed:

1. Supervisor Drake discussed the Kissing Bridge Sewer Agreement with the Board. He has had telephone contact with the DEC and had addressed their concerns.

2. Supervisor Drake informed the Board that NYS came out to look at the Craneridge plant/Ridgeview pumping station. There is no phone alarm and a dialer needs to be installed. Initially the quote was \$7,000 but one has been located for \$2,700. Gerwitz McNeil will be installing this. The phone line will be between \$200-\$300 for installation. There are two pumping stations up there and the other pumping station does have a phone line; when the phone system was changed no one could figure out the telephone number was so that will be re-installed.

3. The Resolution for Robert Rosenswie on the Agenda will be tabled at the request of the family. This will be on the January Agenda so that the family can attend.

4. Councilman Snyder asked the difference between a Court Officer and a Constable. There is normally one Constable; the person in charge and then there are Court Officers. There are certain qualifications to be a Constable. A Constable needs to be a Peace Officer. There were two applicants for the Court Officer position. The one on the Agenda to be appointed tonight could be a Constable as well. It may be in January that the Board will be asked to hire the second applicant as a substitute.
