**ITEM #3: Citizen Participation**

a) Edward Wright Home Occupation Permit

The members had received Mr. Wright's entire Home Occupation Permit packet prior to the meeting. Mr. Wright reviewed the details of his business with the members:

- Mr. Wright's Home Occupation Permit would be for online federal firearms license.
- There would be no foot traffic.
- There would be no storefront.
- Mr. Wright would be the only person involved; no employees.
- Mr. Wright would conduct background checks.
- Mr. Wright would assist in transfer of ownership of firearms.
- Mr. Wright would not be maintaining a large inventory of firearms on his premises.
- There would be no discharging of firearms on the premises; there will be no shooting range.
- There would be deliveries to his home via UPS, USPS and FedEx.
- Mr. Wright has filed has dba with Erie County under the name of Wm Wright and Son Buffalo. This is a family business name which originated in the UK in 1756. At that time it was Wm Wright and Son Lincoln.
- Mr. Wright is in the process of completing his Federal Firearms License and that license is contingent on the Town's approval of his Home Occupation Permit.

Mr. Wright and the Board discussed his background and the reason for his relocation to Springville. There were no further questions or comments. J. Jozwiak made the motion, seconded by K. Lux, to recommend the Town Board approve the Home Occupation Permit of Edward Wright as reviewed by the Planning Board at the next Town Board Meeting on September 12th. All in favor. Carried.
