Supervisor Drake opened the hearing at 6:00 p.m. Town Clerk Schweikert had published the Notice of Public Hearing in the Springville Journal on September 16, 2021. The Public Hearing Notice was posted on the signboard at the Town Hall and on the Town's website: townofconcordny.com on September 14, 2021.

Supervisor Drake asked those in attendance if anyone had any comments. G. Donhauser asked Supervisor Drake to tell them what has been done in the past with CDBG grant money. The past projects included the Rural Transit Van, Senior Center parking lot, Senior Center generator and the Concord Van.

Supervisor Drake was advised that this year applications could be submitted for ADA compliant projects. For this year's project, the Board will be submitting an application to have the Town Hall bathrooms updated to be ADA compliant. The Town Hall has more foot traffic now that the Town Clerk's office also collects the Springville Griffith School taxes; people are coming into Town Hall from various neighboring towns.

Supervisor Drake asked if anyone else wanted to address the Board and there were no other comments.
