Supervisor Drozd opened the meeting at 7:10 a.m.

ITEM #1: PRESENTATION OF THE 2024 TENTATIVE BUDGET

Town Clerk Schweikert presented the Tentative Budget to the Board. Supervisor Drozd advised the Board that General Fund A in this Tentative Budget is \$4.08 which is an increase of \$.38/\$1,000. The average assessed value for a home in the Town is \$67,631 which would be an increase of \$25.46 on the annual tax bill. The average assessed value for a home in the Village is \$56,214 which would be an increase of \$21.28 on the annual tax bill. Supervisor Drozd noted that there are constant maintenance expenses and the Town can't let these projects go year after year without addressing them: windows, air conditioners, doors.

Motion by Council Member Zittel, seconded by Council Member Drake, to accept the 2024 Tentative Budget for the Town of Concord as presented by the Town Clerk. Council Members Drake & Zittel; Supervisor Drozd, voting aye; Council Members Snyder & Krzemien, excused. Carried.

The Board will by scheduling another Budget Work Session to review this Tentative Budget.
