Separate sealed Bids for the **Town of Concord Hulbert Library – Parking Lot Paving**, will be received by the Town of Concord, hereinafter called the Owner, located at 86 Franklin Street, P.O. Box 368, Springville, New York 14141, until **10:00 a.m. prevailing time on June 3, 2022** and then at that time and place opened and read aloud.

The Work shall be performed under a single contract and shall include but not be limited to the following: Paving the existing parking lots and driveways, including some areas of full depth base repair, and stormwater drainage improvements at the Town of Concord Hulbert Library, located at 18 Chapel Street, Springville, NY 14141.

All Bids being mailed (including FedEx, UPS, Priority Mail, etc.) or hand-delivered to the Town of Concord shall be directed to Darlene Schweikert, Town Clerk at the address listed above in a sealed envelope. The envelope shall be clearly marked on the outside **“Town of Concord Hulbert Library – Parking Lot Paving”** Failure to follow the above instructions could result in rejection of the proposal.

Each Bid shall be accompanied by a certified check or Bid Bond in the amount of five percent (5%) of the amount of the Bid made payable to the "Town of Concord". All Bid Bonds shall be on a form acceptable to the Owner, duly executed by the Bidder as Principal and having as surety thereon, a surety company approved by the Owner. No Bidder may withdraw their Bid within forty-five (45) days of the Bid Opening.
