Supervisor Eppolito opened the hearing at 6:20 p.m. Town Clerk Schweikert had published the Notice of Public Hearing in the Springville Journal on September 15<sup>th</sup>, 2016.

Each year the County requires the Town to hold a Public Hearing. He explained the purpose of the hearing was for discussion on the Community Development Block Grant application. Supervisor Eppolito recommended to the Board that the Town rank the Rural Transit Van Service as the number one project. This program is of extreme importance in serving the older residents and handicapped individuals in the Town of Concord/Village of Springville for whom transportation to medical appointments and other basic functions is very difficult to obtain.

Supervisor Eppolito noted that senior projects such as exercise equipment are fundable and he hopes next year that the Town would be ready to move forward with that.
