STATE OF EMERGENCY DECLARATION

A State of Emergency is hereby declared in the Town of Concord for a period of time beginning at 800 hours on the date of November 13, 2020 and continuing in effect for a period of time not to exceed 30 days.

The State of Emergency has been declared due to the emergency conditions produced by:

Public health crisis caused by Coronavirus Disease 2019 (Covid-19)

Such conditions threaten or imperil the public safety of the residents and businesses in the Town of Concord.

As Chief Executive of The Town of Concord, I Clyde M. Drake, Town Supervisor have exercised the Authority given to me under New York Executive Law Section 24, to preserve the public safety and render all required and available assistance vital to the security, well-being and health of the citizens of the community.

I hereby direct the Department(s) of: All Town of Concord Departments

To take whatever steps necessary to protect life and property, public infrastructure and other such emergency assistance as deemed necessary.
