Sealed bids for construction of a new Community Park Pavilion for the Town of Concord will be received at the Town Clerk's Office, 86 Franklin Street, P.O. Box 368, Springville, NY 14141, until 10:00 a.m. on Tuesday, October 11, 2022 and then at that time and place publicly opened and read aloud.

All bids being mailed or hand-delivered to the Town of Concord shall be directed to Darlene Schweikert, Town Clerk, at the address listed above, in a sealed envelope. The envelope shall be clearly marked on the outside "Town of Concord Construction of New Community Park Pavilion."

The contract documents may be examined at the office of Schenne & Associates Consulting Engineers. Each bid shall be accompanied by a certified check or Bid Bond in the amount of five percent (5%) of the amount of the bid made payable to the "Town of Concord." All Bid Bonds shall be on a form acceptable to the Town of Concord, duly executed by the bidder as principal and having as surety thereon, a surety company approved by the Town of Concord. No bidder may withdraw their Bid within sixty (60) days of the Bid Opening.

The Town of Concord Board reserves the right to reject any and all bids, waive any informalities therein, and award on the basis of best interest of the Town of Concord.
