Separate sealed Bids for the **Town of Concord, Kissing Bridge Pump Station and Forcemain**, will be received by the Town of Concord, hereinafter called the Owner, located at 86 Franklin Street, Springville, New York 14141, until **3:00 p.m. prevailing time on October 3, 2023** and then at that time and place opened and read aloud.

The Work shall be performed under a single contract, and shall include, but is not limited to, the following: Construction of new Grinder Pump Station and 1.5" HDPE forcemain, approximately 1,100 linear feet in total length from the Kissing Bridge WWTP to the Craneridge WWTP. Construction will primarily involve horizontal directional drilling (HDD) installation of the forcemain, installation of appurtenances, installation of a duplex grinder pump station, and decommissioning of the existing wastewater treatment plant.

A Pre-Bid Conference will be held at 10:00 a.m. on Wednesday, September 20, 2023 at the Concord Town Hall located at 86 Franklin Street, Springville, New York 14141. It is strongly recommended that all perspective bidders attend the Pre-Bid Conference.

All BIDS being mailed (including FedEx, UPS, Priority Mail, etc.) or hand-delivered to the Town of Concord shall be directed to Darlene Schweikert, Town Clerk at the address listed above in a sealed envelope. The envelope shall be clearly marked on the outside "**Town of Concord, Kissing Bridge Pump Station and Forcemain.**" Failure to follow the above instructions could result in rejection of the proposal.

The Contract Documents may be examined at the office of MDA Consulting Engineers, PLLC. Anyone wishing to examine the Contract Documents should be advised to call ahead and confirm times in which the Contract Documents can be examined at the office (716) 699-4650. Each Bid shall be accompanied by a certified check or Bid Bond in the amount of five percent (5%) of the amount of the Bid made payable to the "Town of Concord". All Bid Bonds shall be on a form acceptable to the Owner, duly executed by the Bidder as Principal and having as surety thereon, a surety company approved by the Owner. No Bidder may withdraw their Bid within sixty (60) days of the Bid Opening.

The Town of Concord, in order to promote its established Affirmative Action Plan, invites sealed bids from NYS Certified MBE/WBE Contractors. This Affirmative Action Policy regarding sealed bids and contracts applies to all persons without regard to race, color, national origin, age, sex, or handicap. This project has goals for MBE/WBE project participation. **The project goal is 20% combined M/WBE participation.**

The bidder acknowledges to and for the benefit of the Town of Concord (Owner) and the State of New York (the State) that it understands the goods and services under this project are being funded with monies made available by the Clean Water State Revolving Fund that have statutory requirements commonly known as "American Iron and Steel;" that requires all of the iron and steel products used in this project to be produced in the United States ("American Iron and Steel Requirement") including iron and steel products provided by the Bidder pursuant to this Agreement. All of the iron and steel products used in the project will be and/or have been produced in the United States in a manner that complies with the American Iron and Steel Requirement, unless a waiver of that requirement is approved.
